Precision Piecing is a 6-hour workshop. This workshop is targeted for piecers who want to improve their sewing skills. We will make the lap size "Science Fair" quilt from Jaybird Quilts. I'll teach you how to use the Hex N More ruler, also from Jaybird Quilts. This is a fast pattern that yields great results! We will talk about pressing, rotary cutting, piecing and finishing. I'll have lots of great tips on how to be a better quilter.

Trying to decide on fabrics? If you google "Science Fair Quilts", you will see lots of color ideas.

## Supply list:

- -Sewing machine in good working order
- -Spray starch or sizing
- -Small rotary mat if you have one. We will have big mats but it's nice to have your own.
- -A small travel iron and press board if you want. Again, we will have ironing boards and irons but you will be pressing!
- -Sharp rotary cutter. ☺
- -Hex N More ruler from Jaybird Quilts. I'll have them for sale if you need one. \$23
- -"Science Fair" pattern from Jaybird Quilts. Again, I will have them for sale. \$10
- -A grouping of 2 ½" strips or a jelly roll. If you want to cut from fat quarters, that's fine. I'll be doing a demo with fat quarters.
- -1 5/8 yards of background.
- -Basic sewing kit (pins, scissors, seam ripper, etc.)
