Welcome to Sashiko - an Introduction to the Japanese Art of Hand Stitching Sashiko (little stab) is the famous white-on-indigo quilted work we associate with Japanese costume of the 19th and early 20th century. Revived in the 1970s, sashiko is once more a beloved craft in Japan and admired around the world. If you've always wanted to try sashiko, this is your opportunity. A kit, provided by the instructor, costs \$22 and contains: 1/2 yd sashiko-printed fabric, traditional sashiko thread, a pack of sashiko needles, a Japanese-style ring thimble or a

traditional western thimble, and written directions for sashiko plus a project for a wall hanging.
