## QUILT SHOW CERTIFIED JUDGE, KAREN KENDO

Karen has always been drawn to quilts and remembers sleeping under a quilt made by her grandmother which she still owns. Being a quilter was put on the back burner while she pursued a career in education - teaching Chemistry and Physics, working with the Gifted and Talented program, and being a school administrator. But the desire to create quilts was always there.
In 1995, Karen purchased a book on quilt-making and has not looked back since! She soon discovered the wonderful world of quilt shops and quilt guilds and even Internet quilting. Karen became an avid machine piecer and appliquér turning out many quilt tops each year. Some of these she quilted herself on her domestic sewing machine, and some she sent out to be quilted by a longarm quilting service. In 2005, Karen purchased her first longarm quilting machine and a new world opened up to her
By 2006 she had quilted many of her own quilt tops and those of friends, and began quilting as a service for others. Much to her delight, she and others she quilted for immediately began
winning ribbons at quilt shows. This spurred Karen to pursue longarm quilting as a full time business. In 2007, Quilting with Karen, was born.
Always eager to learn more, Karen took a class in quilt judging in 2006 and worked on the judging floor at shows as an assistant and a scribe under many NQA certified judges. She has judged guild shows in South Carolina and beyond, including Carolina Pine Quilters in Aiken, York County Quilters in Rock Hill, the Asheville, NC quilt show, the Upcountry Quilt Guild, the Foothills Quilt Guild, the Coastal Carolina Fair, the Orangeburg County Fair and the Sumter County Fair. Karen is a certified quilt judge through the National Association of Certified Quilt Judges.
